RULES AND REGULATIONS

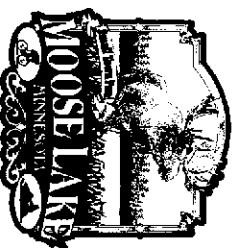
1. We reserve the right to evict, **without refund**, anyone who does not respect the campground rules, or does not respect fellow campers.
2. All guests must register. Please see the fee schedule.
3. No waste water (including gray water) is to be dumped on the ground. Please use the provided dump station.
4. Put all garbage in the dumpsters. If you clean fish, please wrap the remains well in plastic bags.
5. All pets **MUST BE ON LEASH**. Please clean up after them.
6. Please take short showers so everyone has hot water.
7. Quiet hours are from **10:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.** The campground is **police patrolled**. During this time, children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult if they are not on their camping site.
8. There is a 5 MPH Speed Limit within the campground. There are many children, please drive carefully.
9. If the entrance gate is closed, please open the gate, then close it after you enter.
10. No firearms or fireworks may be discharged or displayed in the campground.
11. Motor bikes and ATVs are to be used only to and from campsites. Pleasure riding within the campground confines is prohibited.
12. All fires must be attended. **NO TREE CUTTING**.
13. Only one picnic table per site, unless special arrangements are made.
14. Only one unit per site, unless special arrangements are made.
15. **CHECKOUT TIME IS AT 2:00 P.M.**

We are sorry, but we are not, and can not be responsible for lost or stolen items. Firewood is available.

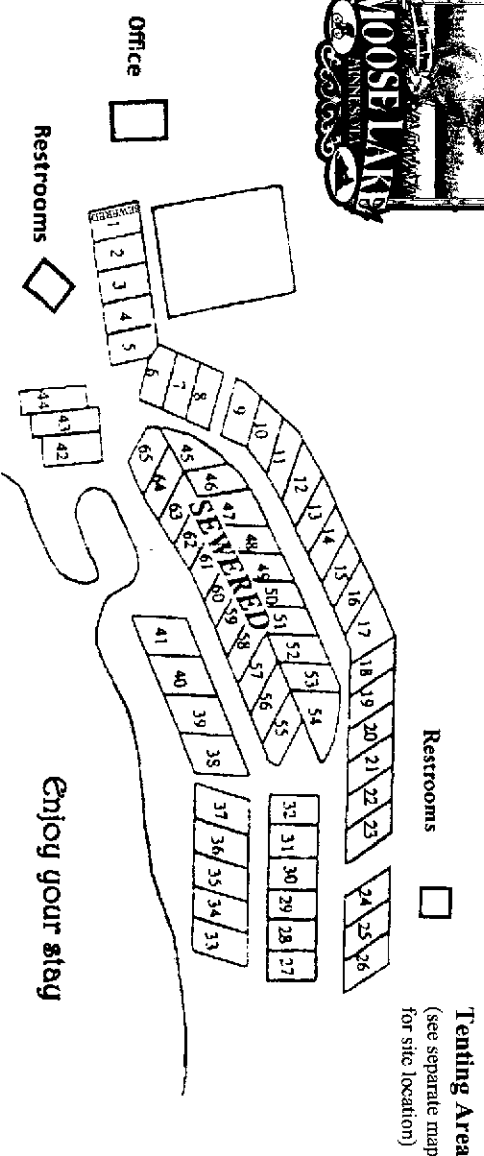

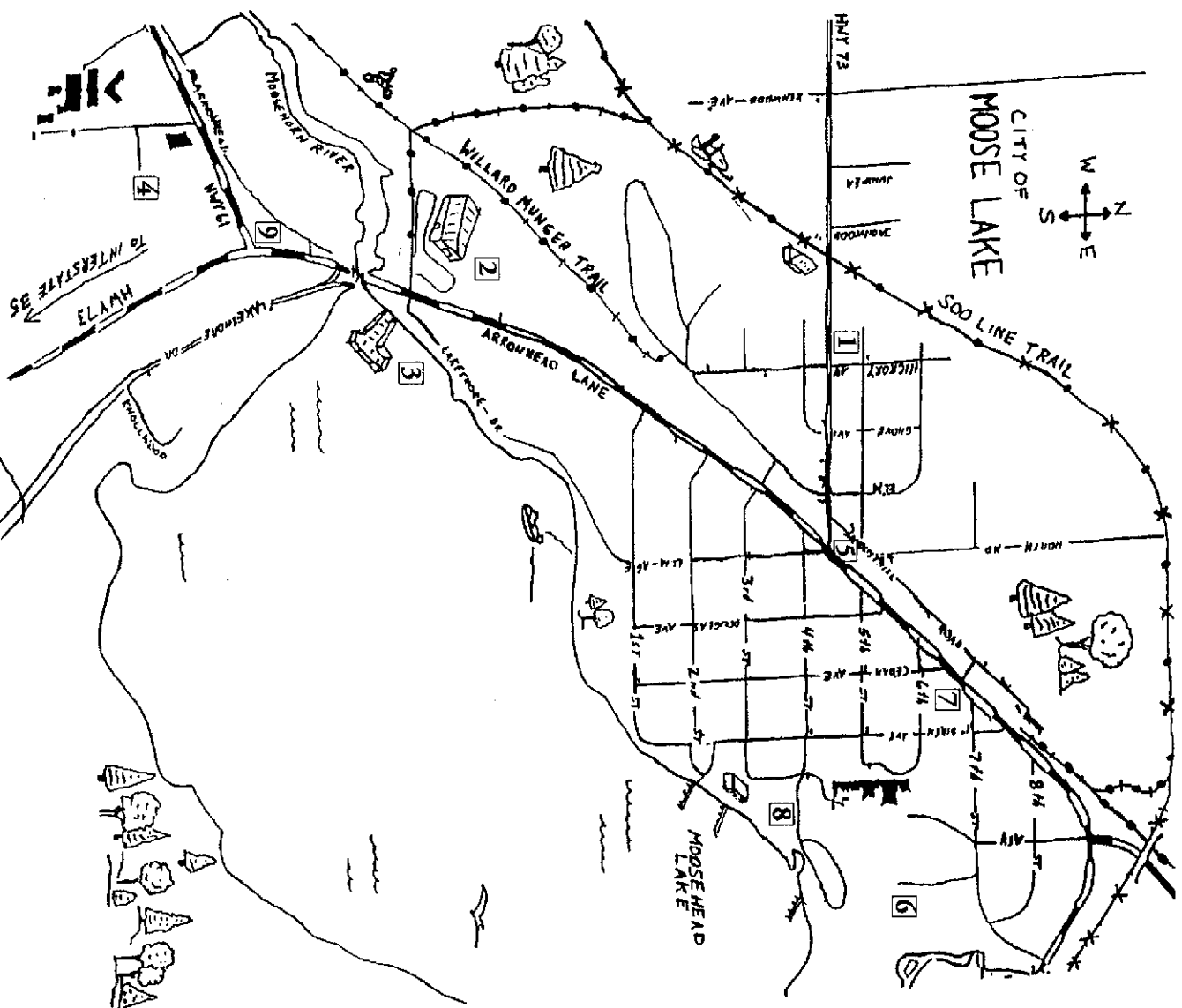

Welcome to Moose Lake Parks and Recreation Areas

- 1. ROY PETERSON MEMORIAL PARK** Established in 1991 on land donated by the county, the park features a paved basketball playing surface, playground equipment and limited picnicking area. The park is named after a longtime resident of the Soo Hill neighborhood.
- 2. RIVERSIDE ARENA** This arena, with artificial ice, has proved itself as an indoor ice rink during the winter months for high school and recreational youth hockey programs, in addition to pleasure skating. During summer months, the arena is available for rent and can accommodate a variety of activities, as restroom and concession areas are available. For arena rental, contact the City of Moose Lake office.
- 3. LAKESIDE REST AREA** Completed in 1989, the rest area allows for picnicking and photo opportunities of Moosehead Lake. Excellent fishing opportunities also exist with the handicapped accessible fishing pier.
- 4. TWILIGHT PARK** More commonly known as the Mercy Hospital Ballfield, Twilight Park is one of two City operated ball fields. Built first for little league and then later switched for use with area softball leagues, the field has bleachers for spectator viewing and an ample parking area. The field is available for summer use, however, prior arrangements should be made to avoid scheduling conflicts.
- 5. CENTENNIAL SQUARE** Dedicated in 1989 as part of the City of Moose Lake's Centennial celebration, the square is available for a rest area with limited picnicking space. The square features flagpoles dedicated to the veterans of the area and a gazebo honoring longtime community residents, the Berquist family. Many of the town's summer activities are centered on the square.
- 6. FERRY HALVERSON FIELD** Through the aid of the Moose Lake Baseball Association, a new little league field was constructed and is used through the summer months as part of the joint City, School and Township summer recreation programs.
- 7. VETERAN'S SQUARE** Dedicated to the veterans of the area, the square is a place of honor to those who have given their lives in the service of their Country. A memorial to area veterans is at the center place of the square.
- 8. CITY PARK AND CAMPGROUND** The City Park has a full beach and camping facilities side by side. Changing and restrooms are available, along with lifeguards on duty in the beach area. A full kitchen pavilion is available for rent, along with a handshell an covered picnic area. The campground features full water and electric hookups. Selected sites also have sewer hookups. In addition, there is a wilderness tenting area near the Moosehorn River. Two boat landings and a boat lagoon are available along with a complete playground and adjacent tennis courts. This campground is open from mid-May until late September.
- 9. VISITOR'S CENTER** Home of the Moose Lake Area Chamber of Commerce and the City's nine foot high moose mascot. The visitor's center has information on upcoming events for the seasons and can assist visitors with other area information.
