

ORDINANCE NO. 2

The Village of Council of Moose Lake, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Misdemeanors

Section 1. Lurking in building or yard with intent to do mischief, etc.

Any person or persons who shall be found lurking, lying in wait or concealed in any house or other building, or in any part of premises within the limits of the Village of Moose Lake, with intent to do any mischief, or to steal, or to commit any offense prohibited by the laws of this state, or by the ordinances of the Village, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 2. Noise, riot, disturbance- Collecting in crowds.

Any person or persons who shall make, aid or countenance or assist in any noise, riot, disturbance or improper diversion to the annoyance or disturbance of the citizens, or other person or person said city; or who collect in bodies or crowds in any street or public place in said village so as to obstruct public travel there on, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 3. Nudity, Indecent dress, Indecent exposure, immoral conduct, indecent books, Pictures, plays.

Any person or person who shall appear in any street or public place in said village in a state of nudity, or in a dress not belonging to his or her sex, or in any indecent or lewd dress, or shall make any indecent exposure of his or her person, or be guilty of any obscene or filthy act, or any lewd, indecent, immoral, or insulting conduct, language or behavior, or shall exhibit sell or offer to sell any indecent or lewd book picture or other thing or shall exhibit or perform any indecent, immoral, or lewd play or other representation, shall be guilty of misdemeanor.

Section 4. Bathing without bathing dress.

Any person or persons who shall swim or bathe in any river, creek, or lake within the limits of said Village of Moose Lake, between the hours, of 6 o'clock A.M. and 9 o'clock P.M. with out being suitably clad in a bathing dress, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 5. Letting male to female animal.

Any person who shall let any male animal to any female animal within the limits of said village, unless in some enclosed place out of the public view, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 6. Trespassing on private premises.

No person shall trespass on the private premises of others in said Village of Moose Lake. Any person found guilty of a violation of this provision shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 7. Loitering after midnight, lying in wait, consorting with thieves and prostitutes.

No person shall loiter about the streets after midnight and lie in wait of concealment in said Village of Moose Lake, or consort with thieves, prostitutes or other questionable characters. Any person found guilty of a violation of this provision shall be guilty of misdemeanor.

Section 8. Drinking intoxicants on streets or while trespassing on private premises.

No person shall upon the public streets, lanes, or alleys of said Village or being a trespasser upon the private premises of another, drink beer or other intoxicating beverage. Any person found guilty of this provision shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 9. Trespassers sleeping or lying concealed in box cars, barns, etc.

No person being a trespasser shall sleep or lie concealed in any box cars, barn, or any other private premises in said Village of Moose Lake, Any Person found guilty of a violation of this provision shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 7. Petroleum, etc not to stand on railway siding or at depot, how long.

No person or persons, firm or corporation shall leave standing on any railway siding or at any depot within the corporate limits of said village, any of the articles mentioned in section 1, of this ordinance for a longer period than forty-eight (48) hours after arrival.
