AN ORDINANCE REPEALING A CERTAIN ORDINANCE IN THE VILLAGE OF MOOSE LAKE,
MINNESOTA.

Section 1- Ordinance repealed.

The following ordinance of the Village of Moose Lake, Minnesota is hereby repealed; Ordinance no. 26, dated May 5th, 1936, and entitled "An Ordinance for the purpose of promoting safety, order, convenience, and General Welfare, by regulating and restricting the use of land, the location, construction, use and arrangement of buildings and lots for the construction, establishment and use of Gasoline filling stations in the Village of Moose Lake, Minnesota.
