

AN ORDINANCE REFERRING TO RESISTING ARREST WITHIN THE CITY  
LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MOOSE LAKE

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOOSE LAKE ORDAINS:

Section 1. Resisting Arrest.

A. No person shall intentionally do an act which he could reasonably expect to delay, obstruct, resist or interfere with or entice another to delay, obstruct, resist or interfere with a peace officer or other public official in discharging or attempting to discharge a duty of his office.

B. No person shall assault, attempt to assault, threaten to assault, nor in any manner physically resist, delay, obstruct or interfere with a peace officer or other public official in the exercise of his duties.

Section 2. Penalty.

Any person who violates any Section of this Ordinance shall be punished according to the laws of the State of Minnesota. Violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor which shall be punishable by a fine up to \$500.00 or ninety (90) days in jail, or both.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
